Audience capacity:

Children with disabilities: 6 children with disabilities + 24 adults (parents, teachers, etc.), in total 30 people

Babies: 12 babies + 28 adults (parents, teachers, etc.), in total 40 people

Company traveling: 3-4 people

Set up time 2-3h Take down 1h

Stage

- preferable black box, but adaptable to space conditions
- 8 x 8 m dance floor (from the venue)
- audience is seating from 4 sides on the carpet we bring (see photo)
- rigging or equivalent to hang ribbons (see photo)

Lights

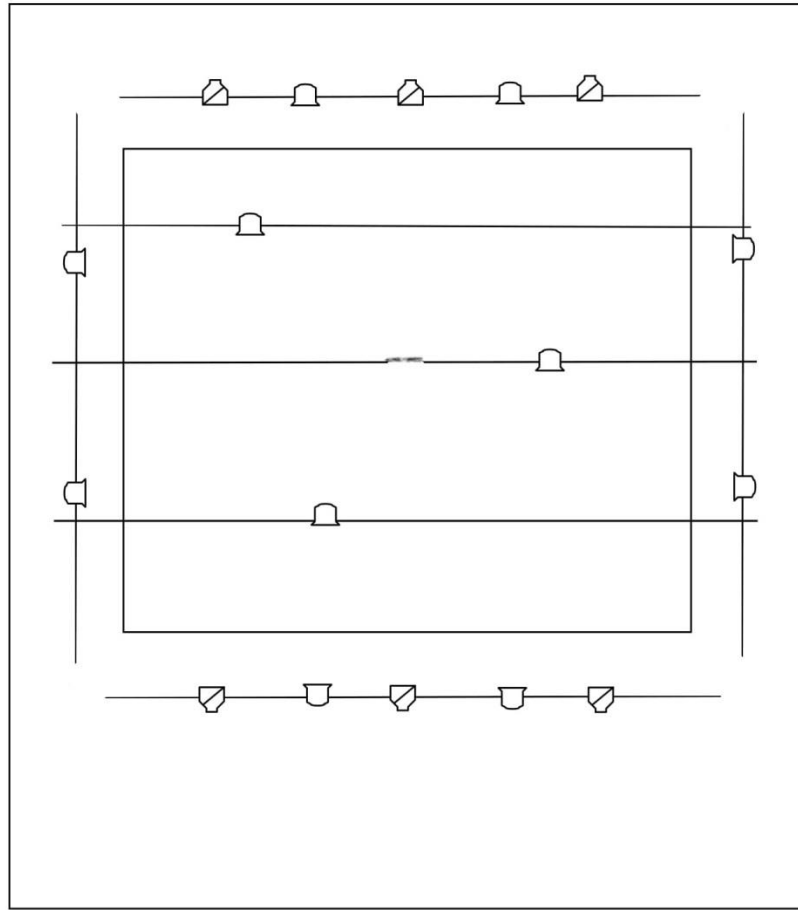
6 LED PAR (warm white, magenta, blue)
8 PARNel or equivalent
3 PAR 64 or profile or equivalent
Lights can be adapted to venue equipment
24 channels dimming console

Sound PA system of good quality and sufficient for the house. Sound console with minijack for computer

Note: lighting board and sound mixer must be close to each other.
